Dear Sir/Madam,

As foreseen in the Council Regulation No 199/2008, the Commission herewith asks Member States to provide aggregated scientific data from within their National Data Collection programs as detailed in Commission Decision of 18 December 2009¹ to support scientific advice in EU fisheries.

The table in the annex gives an overview of the data² requested for submission under this call. Table 1 concerns data requested for the years 2008-2012 (collected under the DCF legislation). Please note that the years requested for each parameter type in table 1 vary depending on expected availability. In addition to fleet segment level data, national totals are also requested for all parameters.

² The data will be processed and analysed by JRC and STECF experts to produce the draft of the report on the "Economic Performance of EU Sector: Annual Report 2012" and to provide scientific data support to the FIRMS project managed by FAO.

Member States should follow the agreed procedure for transmission of data (by uploading onto the JRC server).

Therefore the Member States are encouraged to respect the above mentioned deadline and to provide all requested data.
