Subject:	Call for fleet economic scientific data concerning 2008-2013			

Message:

Dear Sir/Madam,

As foreseen in the Council Regulation No 199/2008, the Commission herewith asks Member States to provide aggregated scientific data from within their National Data Collection programs as detailed in Commission Decision 93/2010¹ to support scientific advice in EU fisheries.

The table in the annex gives an overview of the data² requested for submission under this call. Table 1 concerns data requested for the years 2008-2013 (collected under the DCF legislation). Please note that the years requested for each parameter type in Table 1 vary depending on expected availability. Fleet segment level data and national totals are requested for all parameters. In addition, the theoretical maximum number of days at sea and/or KW-days at sea per fleet segment is requested at the fleet segment level. This

parameter is required to estimate the technical indicator *Capacity utilisation*, as described in the Commission Services Guidelines for the assessment of the balance between fishing capacity and fishing opportunities,. Please note that the submission of this data is not compulsory under the DCF but is highly recommended on a voluntary basis.

Member States should follow the agreed procedure for transmission of data (by uploading data onto the JRC server).

Full details of all the parameters (including the theoretical maximum days at sea), aggregation levels and uploading instructions for this call can be found on the JRC data collection website: <u>https://datacollection.jrc.ec.europa.eu/data-calls</u>

Each Member State requires a password in order to submit data. These passwords remain unchanged from the previous call for economic data. Member States who no longer have a record of their password, should contact the JRC data submission team by emailing <u>datasubmission@jrc.ec.europa.eu</u>.

As per Article 20 of Council Regulation No 199/2008, Member States are kindly requested to supply the data as specified within **1 month** from receipt of this request for data.

According to Articles 8(4) and 8(5) of Council Regulation No 199/2008, reductions of European Union financial assistance may be applied by the Commission in case of lack of data transmission by the Member States within the specified deadline and as specified in the request. Therefore the Member States are encouraged to respect the above mentioned deadline and to provide all requested data.
