



Furthermore, we request data on number of enterprises and turnover attributed to fish processing, pertaining to years 2008-2012 for enterprises that carry out fish processing but not as a main activity.

Although in last year's data call data at the segment level were requested only on a voluntary basis, in this year's data call Member States are requested to provide the data at segment level if it is specified as such under their National Programmes. The intent is to use disaggregated data in order to analyse and compare the profitability of the different categories of firms. The analysis of the economic performance of the various categories of fish processing firms will be part of the Terms of Reference for the 2014 Economic Report on fish processing sector.


